## This funding will be used to

- Ensure students continue to reach National Minimum Standards in Reading, Writing and Numeracy or have an individual learning plan to address their specific learning needs.
- Develop fundamental literacy, numeracy and social skills of 3 to 5 year old children in the Goomeri Community to ease their transition to school.
- Focus on fundamental literacy, numeracy and speech development of P to 3 students.
- Close the gap between Indigenous and Non-Indigenous students in all aspects of the curriculum.
- Continued implementation of a whole school community program focusing on resilience, leadership and the value of education.
- Continue improvement of NAPLAN student performance in the upper two bands.

## Our initiatives include


- Use 2018 NAPLAN and PAT R data to explicitly review / improve Goomeri's whole school reading strategy – "Reading Club", via the inquiry model.
- Review and continue development of a whole school "Writing" approach.
- Use 2018 NAPLAN and PAT M data to inform teacher pedagogy with respect to numeracy.
- An emphasis on "Higher Order Thinking" in all classrooms with a focus on students on the cusp of NAPLAN's upper two bands.
- Continue "Get Set for Prep", including parent workshops to support the development of early foundational social, literacy and numeracy skills.
- Foster and continue development of the P-3 Speech Language Program utilising: PAL, Monkey Sounds, Strive, Blanks and individualised student speech / sound programs.
- Continue student development with respect to well-being, leadership and resilience through TEAM – "Together Everyone Achieves More", leadership camps, PBL and "Brekky Matters".
